
Park City Children's Theatre is a not-for-profit organization providing a safe and educational space for children creating growth opportunities in performances which develops excellent character.

History





Finances

The finances for Park City Children's Theatre have consistently increased while the organization has continued expansion and community involvement. The total revenue for 2032 was \$558,120 and the total expenses were \$524,350. Our main focus for fundraising is constructing our new building, and that fundraiser's goal is \$1,000,000. Any leftover funding will be used for either equipment for the building or scholarships for children.
